However, in places like Kathmandu in Nepal the reality is very different. This is a fun way to learn about Nepal and to help raise funds at the same time! Read the daily suggestion – maybe as a family – and contribute the price given. Maybe keeping the funds in a jar and then counting it up at the end of the month? Or just keeping a running total as you go along. These funds will be used to help provide baby boxes for new mothers in remote areas of Nepal, and at the same time ensure that these mothers and babies are receiving good care and regular check-ups. 1 **COUNT THE TAPS IN YOUR HOUSE**
In Nepal there are water shortages, and before we can drink it, it needs to be filtered. Give thanks to God for clean, running water. Give **10p** for each tap you have.

2 **DO YOU OWN A SHOWER?**
Many homes in Nepal don't have a shower and washing is done at a public tap. If they do have a shower, often they are unheated. Give **50p** for this real privilege.

3 **COUNT THE JARS IN YOUR CUPBOARDS**
There is so much variety in the supermarkets! Give **2p** for each jar.

4 **COUNT THE THINGS MADE FROM GRAIN IN YOUR KITCHEN**
Thank God for making grain grow. Give **10p** for each item.

5 **COUNT YOUR PILLOWS AND CUSHIONS**
Give **10p** for each one to remember people who are less comfortable.

6 **COUNT THE RADIATORS IN YOUR HOUSE**
It gets cold in Kathmandu in the winter. While outside might be a nice temperature during the day, indoors it can be near freezing. Give **5p** per radiator.

7 **HOW FAR IS IT TO YOUR DOCTORS?**
Some people walk for miles to see a doctor, often it will be a few days walk across mountainous roads. If your journey is less than three miles give **50p**.

8 **HOW MANY CARS DOES YOUR FAMILY HAVE?**
The main mode of transport in Nepal is by foot or by bicycle. In Kathmandu some own scooters. Give **50p** for each car.

9 **HOW DO YOU GET TO YOUR CHURCH?**
Give **10p** if you walk, **20p** if you cycle, or **50p** if you go by car.

10 **DO YOU HAVE A TELEVISION?**
– to keep you entertained? Give **20p** for each television in your home.

11 **HOW MANY LIGHTBULBS IN YOUR HOME?**
Most houses in Kathmandu will be lit by candle at night. Give **2p** per light bulb, and thank God you can see easily at night.

12 **COUNT THE BOTTLES IN YOUR FRIDGE**
Thank God for tasty drinks. Give **2p** for each bottle or container.

13 **COUNT THE SINKS AND TOILETS**
Many homes in Nepal don't have their own toilet and have to share one with a whole village. Give **20p** for each one you have.

14 **HOW MANY MEDICINES DO YOU HAVE IN YOUR HOUSE?**
There is no National Health Service in Nepal. Please give **20p** per medicine, or **£2** if you or your family have a cupboard full!

DO YOU HAVE A COMPUTER OR GAMES MACHINE?

Give **2p** for each hour you spend on either today.

DO YOU HAVE ANY PETS?

Please give **50p** for each pet.

DO YOU HAVE A LANDLINE TELEPHONE?

We mostly rely on mobile telephones. Please give **50p** per handset.

HOW MANY PIECES OF FRUIT ARE IN YOUR HOUSE?

Please give **5p** per piece, then have a piece and thank God you can easily buy more at the shops tomorrow.

HOW MANY WINDOWS DO YOU HAVE?

Nepal suffers from heavy rain in the monsoon season. Give **10p** for each window in your home, and thank God for the provision of keeping the rain out of your house.

HOW MUCH MAIL DID YOU GET TODAY?

(Including 'junk' mail) in the post. Nepal doesn't have a postal delivery service and we have to have a PO Box. Give **5p** per item, and **10p** for bills!

IS IT THE WEEKEND? NO SCHOOL!

Give **10p** per child - **50p** if you are a teacher!

HOW MANY HYMNS OR SONGS DID YOU SING TODAY?

Give **10p** per song/hymn, or **5p** if you played an instrument. It's good to sing praise to God!

SHOPPING TODAY?

Are you visiting the supermarket or going shopping today? Please donate **5p** or **10p** for every £1 spent.

HOW MANY COOKING AIDS DO YOU HAVE?

Give **10p** for each, cooker, microwave, hob, oven or other.

HOW MANY UMBRELLAS DO YOU HAVE IN YOUR HOUSE?

During monsoon, rain can ruin crops, so can drought in the winter. Give **10p** per umbrella.

HOW MANY SPOONS ARE THERE IN YOUR HOUSE?

Count them all! Nepali's normally use their hands to eat. Give **1p** for each spoon.

COUNT YOUR COATS

Please give **10p** for each one - even those you don't wear any longer!

DO YOU HAVE A SPECIAL DAY THIS MONTH?

If you have a birthday or anniversary this month please give **50p**, if not please give **20p!**

HOW MANY PLUG SOCKETS ARE THERE IN YOUR HOUSE?

Thank God for electricity that is normally there! It is often not here in Nepal due to power cuts, especially in the winter. Give **1p** for each socket you have. *Have a free day if you have today experienced a power cut!*
